WHAT TO EXPECT: The number of participants will be between 25 and 35. The workshop begins with an evening lecture on the evening of August 21 followed by a 5-day learning adventure to deepen your ability to listen to, learn from and echo nature. Indoor lectures will take place at the Silver Museum in Arjeplog and will be combined with outdoor activities / excursions in the surroundings of Arjeplog. The excursions include hiking in inclement conditions, over rocky and uneven terrain and you must be fit enough to hike up to 1 mile in these conditions. The workshop also includes evening activities. The weather can be unpredictable. Please bring summer outfit as well as warm and water resistant clothing suitable for outdoor activities at all weather conditions. Average temperature in August is 12-14 degrees Celsius.
